Province of North Carolina being in a low State of health

that it is appointed for all men once to die I do make this  
Ordained Constitution & appoint this to be my last Will and  
Testament in Manner & form following That is to say  
First & principally I commend my Soul to Almighty God  
that gave it me hoping to be saved through the only  
Mercy & Medication of our blessed Lord & Saviour  
Jesus Christ. And my Body I commit to the Earth  
from whence it was taken & buried in a Christianlike  
and decent Manner at the Interment of my Executors  
hereafter named not doubting but of the General  
Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the  
Almighty Power of God. And as touching those  
valuable Goods & estate wherewith it hath pleased  
God to bless me with I give & Bequeath & dispose of them  
in the following manner & form:
