above or Earth and in Case that she the said Ann Day and my
wife and Daughter should disagree so that they could not
Consent together then for my wife and Daughter to build
or cause to be built a house for her on my land and
Charges to be paid out of my Estate and the said Ann
Day to be supported out of Estate at the Discretion
of my Executors and my will and meaning is that this
Codicil be adjuged to be part of my last will and Testa-
ment and that all things therein mentioned and Con-
tained be faithfully and truly performed and ac-
fully and amply to Every Respect as if the same was
set Declared and set Down in my last will and Tes-
tament Witness my hand this Twenty first Day
of January one Thousand Seven hundred and ninety

for the remainder part of the Estate and as
stock of all kind and also all the movable estate
that is belonging unto me to be equally divided
amongst my own children to hold as hereby
Beleth we declare the to be my last will and
testaments in the presence of us I do hereby
appoint and desire that my son William Everett
and Thomas Fuller to be Executors of my Estate
that my last will and testaments be fully
done and signed this 1st day of October 1793
