Harter County being of sound and perfect mind & memory do testify  
do this Sixteenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight  
hundred and make & publish this my last Will & Testament in manner following  
that is to say — First I lend unto my Mother Elizabeth Griffen  
my dwelling House wherew I do now live and the one half of my apple  
Richard and the one third part of my plantation and land joining the House  
for her life It is my Will and desire that the rest of my Home Land  
and plantation should be duly rented out and the money arising to be  
for the Support of my Wife and Child while she lives a Widower for  
the Support of my Child till he be seven years of age also it is my  
Will and desire that my brother Richard Luke Moseley shud take my son  
David Griffen when he is seven years old and bring him up and give  
him two years Schooling my Will and desire is that my Land lying  
on the White oak River should be sold & the money arising shud be  
to pay the expence of giving my Child his schooling I give my Cow &  
meal that is now in my House to be equally divided between my wife  
Dulila Griffen and my Mother Elizabeth Griffen Next I give unto my  
Wife Dulila Griffen one feather bed Headstead and furniture I also desire  
that my Matir may be sold and the money arising to be divided between  
my Wife & my Mother and the Wheat that is now growing to be equally divided be  
tween my Wife & my Mother & the Wheat that is now in the house to be equally divid  
ed between my wife & my Mother whereas I am owing Richard Upson  
three Monthes Schooling I desire that he may have it and as many of my  
Hogs told as shall pay the same & that she may have the same number  
Pigs that is called his at this time according to his age & that the rest of  
my Hogs to be equally divided between my wife & my Mother my Will  
and desire is that my Cart & Wheels and my bottle should be sold of the  
money Put at Interest for my Child when come of age and I give the rest  
of my Property to my son David Griffen And I hereby make & ordain  
my Worthy friend Lake Moseley Executer of this my last Will & Testament  
In witness whereof the said William Griffen have to this my last Will and  
Testament set my hand the day & year above written

my other Brothers James Henry & Simon — and I also  
also Give all my Turniture that is in pits and in the Boxes to be  
Equally divided Between my two youngest Brothers Joshua Griffen and  
Simon Griffen In witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and  
Seal to and Sealed and acknowledged in  
in the presence of us
