being in said State hold but thank be to god
all present in my right mind & memory thank be to
god for it and first of all calling to mind the mortality
of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men
once to Die I do make and Ordain this my last will and testament
that is to say principally and first of all I give & recommend my soul
into the hands of God that gave it and my Body I recommend
to the Earth to be buried in Christian like manner at the
direction of my Executors and as for my worldly goods which
with it be pleased God to bless me I give and dispose of them
in the following manner

I then give to my wife Elizabeth and wife Mary Harrison the
hire of my plantation and House I also lend to her one horse

called Jupiter & one Mare called Fanny I also lend to my
wife Mary Harrison one Negro woman named Judith also

lend to my wife the use of all my stock of hogs cattle & sheep out
her upon as long as she liveth I also lend my wife one small

Negro girl named Rose and at my wife's death the said land
to go to my Daughter Mary Harrison I also lend to my dear

Beloved wife Mary Harrison one feather bed and Furniture to
gether with all my house hold Furniture as long as she liveth

and the said should have any more increase to equally divided among
my children that living at that time I then give and

bequeath to my well beloved Son Benjamin Harrison
one Hundred & Twenty Acres of land out of this Survey where

now live lying up the swamp joining Old one Edward Cooper's
line and I also give to my Son Benjamin Harrison one Ridge of

land with all the low swampy land lying on the side
and likewise give to my Son Benjamin Harrison fifty acres

of land lying on the North Side of the Dicks just I give and
bequeath unto my Son Benjamin Harrison the one half

of my Negro boy named Bob to him and his heirs forever
I then give to my well beloved Son Abigail Harrison the man

Plantation between Snow here together with all the remaining
part of said Survey of land which are divided & two acres
more or less in the real Survey two hundred & forty acres
I do give to my son Cullin Harrison one ridge of land lying
on the South side of Devils gutt by the name of the head
ed Island to gather with all the low ground land that is
between the Ridge and the gutt and back and also fifty
acres of Pison land on the North side of the Devils gutt
I also give to my son the one half of my share of
some lot between Cullen Thomsen & him and his
heirs forever in my two thirds of the same and half of Mill
with the two hundred and twenty five acres of land
in the stream Mouth Creek I give to my two sons Cullen
Harrison and Benjamin Harrison to pay my debts if
they think fit I also give to my son Cullen Thomsen
one house called Betsy and all the furniture in it
to him and his heirs forever but I leave my dear
children not to interrupt you in this but let
enjoy the benefit of the same and I bequeath
all the improvements there on which is my desire
and I bequeath to my son Cullin Harrison one Feather
Bed and Furniture I also give to my son Cullin Harrison one
Desk to him and his heirs for ever
I then give to my Daughter Elizabeth Everett one cow & calf for
five pounds to be paid out of my Estate in the term of three
years from this Date I then give to my Daughter
Hannah Gardner one cow & calf or five pounds to be paid out
of my Estate in the term of three years from this Date
I then give to my Daughter Sarah Blount one cow & calf or
five pounds to be paid out of my Estate in the term of
three years from this Date and I hereby constitute and appoint my dear
Beloved Son Benjamin Harrison and my dear Son Cullen
Harrison my sole and full Executors of this my will and
Testament hereby utterly Revoking all former wills by
me at any time made In witness whereof I have

Assented with my hand and affixed my Seal this death Day
of February and in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand
seven hundred and ninety seven signed sealed Published
as my last will and Testament in presence of
John Harrison Junr.
