Esq^r the Land he now lives on as far as the Road as it now stands up

Road likewise all my Blacksmiths tools upon his paying William Esq^r
Seven pounds ten Shillings to him & his heirs forever
Then I give to my son Ambrose Esq^r all the Evidences of my Land be-
cuyling him that my two Daughters shall live on it by they please be
his Death or Marriage likewise I give him my Mill & the Land his life
time then to his eldest Child upon his paying William Esq^r Seven
ten Shillings and if Ambrose dies without heirs to be Equally divided
between John & two Girls & then I give to my Daughter Catharine
one feather Bed & her attire to be given to her off my Son
& her heirs forever
