 Price Sara Harrod Thurbay Gals the said increase to be equally divided
 between the said six children to them and their heirs forever

I give unto my son John Price five shillings sterling to him
 & his heirs forever

I give unto my son Wm Price five shillings sterling to him
 & his heirs forever

I give and bequeath unto my son Dew Price five shillings sterling
 unto him & his heirs forever

I give & bequeath unto my son Daughter Sara Harrod five shillings
 unto her & her heirs forever

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Thurbay Gals five shillings
 sterling unto her & her heirs forever

I do appoint John Price Reuben Price Executors to this will

 I William Price son of the province of North Carolina and of
 Mathew County being weak of Body but of perfect mind &
 memory thanks be to the Almighty for the same and knowing
 that it is appointed for all men to die do make and ordain
 this my last will & testament in manner and form following

I send & bequeath unto my wife Martha Price for life time the
 sea plantation where I formerly lived on and three negroes one by
 the name of Pat one by the name of Hope one by the name of
 Willis and every other thing that I possess beside what I will unto
 my six children

I give and bequeath unto my son John Price to him and his heirs forever
 one hundred and seventy four of Land where I now live on after my wife
 death and half the Orchard at my death and the three hundred acres
 of Cornet land to be equally divided between my three sons that is to
 say Thomas Price William Price and John Price to them and their heirs
 forever

I give and bequeath unto my three sons after my wife death one still
 that is to say Thomas Price William Price & John Price to them and
 their heirs forever

I send and bequeath unto my Daughter Ann Price one negro woman
 named Pat and her increase from this date her lifetime and to her heirs
 of said Ann Price should die without lawful heirs of her Body or have
 heirs and they die before they come to age the said negro woman named
 Pat and her increase from this date to be equally divided between my
 three sons Thomas Price William Price & John Price unto them and
 their heirs forever

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Ann Price unto her and her
 heirs forever one Bed and furniture one linen to her

379 I lend unto my Daughter Martha Pittman one negro girl
named Rose and her increase her lifetime and to her heirs for
of said Martha Pittman should die and her heirs should die
before the come of age the said negro girl named Rose and her
increase to be equally divided Between my three sons Thomas
Pier William Pier and John Pier to them and their heirs
forever

I lend and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Mitchell
one negro Boy named Willie her lifetime and to her heirs of
the said Elizabeth Mitchell should die and her heirs should
die before they come of age the said negro Boy named Willie
to be equally divided between my three sons Thomas Pier
William Pier & John Pier to them and their heirs forever
and at my wife's death every thing that she leaves be equally
divided between my three sons & three Daughters

I do hereby appoint Thomas Pier William Pier & John
Pier Executors to this my Will given from under my hand
and Seal this 24th day of Jan^r 1800

Sarah for and during the term of her natural life and after the death
of said Sarah Hyman my Daughter I give and bequeath unto the
children of said Sarah all the property aforesaid of what ever nature
I then I give and bequeath unto Sally Weatherster my Daughter all
the property I have heretofore lent her except the negro girl named and
said negro girl I then I lend unto her during her natural life and after the
death of said Sally I give and bequeath unto said negro girl Sarah and
her increase unto the children of my said Daughter Sally Weatherster
to them and their heirs forever

I then I give and bequeath unto Polly Best my Daughter all the property I have
already lent her except the negro girl named in the one I purchased of Thomas
Best which said negro girl I lend to my Daughter Polly Best for and
during the term of her natural life and after the death of said Polly
