Viz - All my notes or monies due me I give & bequeath to my Mother & at her disposal. 2d My negro boys being to Washington I will that they be sold & the money divided among my three brothers Henry, John & William Share & there o. like. This short form is what I desire, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 5<sup>th</sup> day of January A.D. 1820 -

" In the name of God Amen. I William Hamilton of the County of Rockingham State of N Carolina, being in a poor state of health, but of sound mind & memory & understanding praised be God. Do make & publish this my last Will & Testament in the manner & form following It is my Will that my body be buried in a Christian decent like埋葬, that my funeral expenses be paid & also all my just debts. I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth all the chattels of my worldly inheritance wherewithal it hath pleased God to bless me withal or that I may be now possessed of or due to me viz three horse creatures, ten horned cattle, some hogs, implements and other furniture, my household necessaries, Cupboards & Kitchen Utensils & work, & whatsoever else may be considered mine in the house I now occupy or about it, or wherewer to be found in this State or out of it - And I hereby disannul all & every other Will or Wills by me hitherto made And I hereby do Appoint my beloved wife Elizabeth Hamilton my sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament. And do declare this to be my last will and Testament this 9<sup>th</sup> day of August 1824
