name & bearing some sores & marks of bodily, but at the same time enjoying
the use of a sound mind having in view the uncertainty of life
Do make & ordain this instrument to be my last will & Testament,
in manner & form following so far as relate to my worldly affairs.
1^o I do declare that all my just debts & funeral expenses be paid
2^o I do will & bequeath to my beloved wife Anna Jackson my negro
man James, a horse beast of his own choice, & his & Anna's to live
at her disposal as she pleases or has for me the one third of all
my land whilst she lives & on the third of the movable property
of my estate behind she remains a widow &c. 3^o All the land
in fee simple of my wife Dorothy to be equally divided share & share
like according to quality & quantity between my three sons
viz Isaac, John & Ephraim Jackson, my wife Dorothy to be
my three sons at her death. 4^o I will that all my movable
property be sold & equally divided between my four children
viz Isaac, John, Ephraim & Eliza Jackson & that part of my money
perfectly mentioned in my wife to fall to my four children if
she marries &c. 5^o I will that my four childrens part of my
movable property mentioned be equally part out on interest in
order to reward them & ensure other persons as my executors
may think prudent. 6^o I do appoint my friend John Harris
again & James Gillespie to execute this, my last will & Testament
Signed sealed & executed in presence of us the subscribing witnesses
this 9th day of April 1800.
