blanket my saddle the one half of my cupboard furniture
my wearing apparel & the balance of my bed clothing

bequeath to be divided into three equal shares between
my said Daughter Mary Deamon & my son William

now the wife of James Simpson her bed & all other

third of my wearing apparel & bedding, share before mention-

woman Hannah & her children that she now has w/

and also I before research out of my Stock to be has for ever.

5th To my son William's daughter Nancy I give & bequeath all
my pictures which are not in the two kids I have before
dispersed off to make her a bed.

I her residue or remainder of my property if there be any I
bequeath to my son William Caldwell to dispose of as he may
think proper, whom I do hereby constitute & appoint
together with his son John to take my executors and to
execute this my last will & testament. In witness I have
hereunto set my hand this 1st day of January AD 1830
