 doth make this my last will & Testament as to the distri-
 bution of my Estate & effects in the manner & form following
 after being decently buried by my Executors —
 First To my son William Calderwell I give & bequeath
 my Negro woman Harriet, my Negro woman Dinah & her fa-
 mily of Christiana ~~children~~ ^{children} as at their Termination in summer
 & all other children ~~children~~ ^{children} which Negro may have at my
 death, my Cupboard, falling leaf Table, a large pine chest
 one small Trunk, one bed & furniture, floor Wash, one set
 of working clothes, fire clothes, fire clothes, all my Kitchen
 furniture, all my stock every description kept on
 hand, land & all I will hereafter dispose of —

2^d To my Daughter Mary Deacon I give & bequeath one
 bedstead & bed, one blanket two sheets four pillow cases
 one board bed. One counterpane on the head of bed stands my floor
 which my saddle the one half of my cupboard furniture
 my wearing clothes & the balance of my bed clothing
 (together with the garn that are in the pine chest I
 bequeath to be divided into three equal shares between
 my said Daughter Mary Deacon & my son William
Calderwell and my son Andrew Calderwell and my daughter Nancy
Calderwell wife of James Calderwell the one third share each —

3^d To Veronica my son William Calderwell daughter Nancy wife of
Thomas White I give & bequeath the other half of my cupboard
furniture that I have not before disposed of, my small
walnut table, one walnut chest, together with the one
third of my wearing clothes & bed clothing, I have before mentioned

4th To my son Andrew Calderwell I give & bequeath my Negro
 woman Henrietta & her children that she now has in

hereafter as far as number then increase also my Real Estate
and all I before reserved out of my Stock to be his for ever.

5th To my son William's daughter Nancy I give & bequeath all
my feathers which are not in the two beds I have before
disposed off to make her a bed.

The residue or remainder of my property if there be any I
bequeath to my son William Caldwell to dispose of as he may
think proper, to whom I do hereby constitute & appoint
together with Lewis Johnston Tutor my Executors and to
execute this my last will & testament. In Witness I have
hereunto set my hand this 1st day of January AD 1830

& memory blessed be God for the same; Do make & declare this
my last will & Testament in the manner & form following Viz
I will my spirit to God that gives it, & my body to be
decently interred in the earth. In the full appearance of
the resurrection of the dead, and as for my worldly
substance I dispose of as follows Viz

I will & bequeath that my daughter Phoebe live on
the plantation on which I now live her lifetime & her
daughter Margaret with her while she remains single
they are to have each & live to work for them while
they live together & Margaret is to have a negro girl
named Matt & her children when she leaves the place
I will to my son John a negro girl named Kelly,

I will to my son William a negro boy Chucky

I will to my son Daniel a negro boy Isack -
