of fire Dogs &c. I give & bequeath unto my Grand Daughter  
Violet Rankin in my Walnut Table. I. I give & bequeath unto  
my Grand daughter Nelly Rankin my pot Latch over & my  
plan Hatch. II. The remainder & remainder of my estate I give  
& bequeath unto my Daughter Jessie Anne after having in my mo-  
rial body in a Christian & decent manner interred where may lie  
in my Grounds to the west of the said house head; If further I do ap-  
point my two trusty friends David Wilson & Thomas Hart to ex-  
ecute my last will & Testament, & I doth by these presents witness etc.

Personal & make void all other Wills & Testaments by me  
made & published. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my

& State of North Carolina being weak in body but of sound mind & memory  
Thankful to God for his favor calling to mind & memory the mortality  
of my body knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die  
I do make & publish this my last Will & Testament that is to say  
principally & first of all I give my soul into the hand of Almighty  
God that gave it, and my body I recommend to the earth to be  
buried in a decent manner at the discretion of my executors  
and leaving such worldly Estate herewith as will pley  
it back to bless me in this life. I give & dispose of the same  
in the following manner & form Viz 1<sup>st</sup> I give & bequeath unto  
my beloved son James L. Davis Teacher, provided that he shall  
be living at the age of 21 to be paid by my executors

2<sup>d</sup> I give & bequeath to my beloved son Jacob Davis Teacher, two hundred to be  
paid as before mentioned. — Item 3<sup>d</sup> I give to my beloved son Robert  
Davis one French Crown at my decease. Item 4<sup>d</sup> I give to my beloved  
son William Davis one French Crown at my decease

5<sup>d</sup> I further direct that all the residue of my property therefore  
not bequeathed I give unto my beloved son John Davis my  
executor & that all my lawful Debt be paid out of the same  
and that the balance of money to said executors use, and further  
I do declare & appoint my beloved son John Davis to execute  
this my last will & testament in witness whereof I have  
signed to set my hand and affixed my seal this 19<sup>th</sup> day  
of June in the year of our Lord 1809.
