 I will give & dispose of in the following manner & form viz
 Item, I will give & bequeath to my beloved Mother one third of
 the plantation on which I now live during her natural life
 Item, It is my further will & pleasure that my plantation be
 afterwards as to & equally divided between my two Brothers
 & sister that is to say William, James & Elizabeth Long share & share
 alike the Survivors to be Year to the Church —
 Item, I will give & bequeath to my beloved brother John Long the
 sum of Five pounds. — It is my will & pleasure that the remain-
 der of my Estate if any there be, be divided among my surviving
 Brother & Sisters — and Lastly I do appoint Wm & James Shupe
 James & Alexander, & Andrew Elliott my sole Executors of this
 my last Will & Testament, Receiving all former Wills, Gifts
 or Bequeathments by me made or given, Confirming this and no
 other to be my last Will & Testament. In Witness whereof I have
 set my hand & affixed my seal this 10th day of July 1801

 God tho' sick & weak in body yet of perfect mind & memory
 Do constitute & appoint this as my this as my last Will & Testament
 & desire it may be revised be all as such viz principally to

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 First of all, I commit my body to the earth & my spirit to
 God, when you sit down as to my worldly affairs, I will that
 they may be disposed of in the following manner, And first
 I order that all my just debts be paid, I then will and
 bequeath to my son John two cloths to be paid out of my
 estate, I give & bequeath to my son Samuel one feather bed &
 blanket, I give & bequeath to my son William that bed &
 furniture that belonged to his sister deceased; I give & bequeath
 to my son James one feather bed & blanket; I give &
 bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth all that was her
 sisters deceased, Likewise two feather beds & furniture
 and all my cattle & all my household furniture and my
 saddle & spinning wheel; I also bequeath to my son Samuel
 one saw & harness such as he may choose, & what may
 remain to be sold to the best advantage to pay my just debts
 And I order & appoint David Shields & Robert Kerr executors
 of this my last will & Testament Given under my hand
 & Seal this 13th day of July in the year of our Lord 1801

 mortality of man & that it is appointed for all men to die
 And whereas it hath pleased God to bless me with the service
 of the good things of this life, It is my will & desires that after
 my decease they should be disposed in the manner & form as
 follows viz - Inprimis I do give & assign my soul to God who
 gave it & my body to the dust to be decently interred at the
 discretion of my Executors & my funeral charges to be paid
 out of the whole of my estate, 2^{dly} I do give & bequeath to my
 beloved wife Martha Lemmond my son James named James
 also the use privilege & benefit of my dwelling house, which
