recommend to the Earth to be buried in a Christian decent  
Manner at the discretion of my Executors, And as touching  
such hereditary Estate which the blessed God has left me with  
I will give & dispose of in the following manner & form 1803  
Hence I will give & bequeath to my beloved Mother our M'dy  
The plantation on which she now lives during her natural life  
of her. It is my further will & pleasure that my plantation be  
appraised at £6000 & divided between my two Brothers  
& sister that is to say William, James & Elizabeth Long & their  
eldest Son the survivorst in due to the deceased —

Hence I will give & bequeath to my beloved brother John Long the  
sum of £1000 per ann. It is my wish & pleasure that he remains  
one of my Estate if any there be, be divided among my surviving  
brothers & sister — and lastly I do appoint first James Peeples  
James & his wife, & Andrew Elliott my sole executors of this  
my last will & Testament, Reserving all former Wills, gifts  
or bequests made by me made or given, confirming this last no  
other to be my last Will & Testament. In witness whereof I have  
set my hand & affixed my seal this 10<sup>th</sup> day of July 1803

blanket, I give & bequeath to my son William that bed &  
furniture that belonged to his sister deceased, I give & bequeath  
to my son James one feather bed & blanket, I give &  
bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth all that was her  
Sister's deceased, Likewise two feather beds & furniture  
and all my bedding & all my household furniture and my  
saddle & spinning wheel, I also bequeath to my son James  
one cow & harness such as he may choose, & what may  
remain to be sold to the best advantage to pay my just debts  
And I order & appoint David Shultz & Robert Karrer  
of this my last will & Testament given under my hand  
I seal this 13<sup>th</sup> day of July in the year of our Lord 1811
