I Alexander Campbell of the State of Kentucky & County of Mecklenburg being of sound mind & Memory (blessed be God for his mercies) but for Advanced in Years & under very declining Circumstances of health Do Publish this my last Will & Testament in manner & form as followeth—

First I commit my body to the dust to be buried in a decent manner at the discretion of my Executors and my soul I commit to God who gave it in hopes of Mercy thro' the precious speaking blood of Jesus Christ— And touching such worldly estate with which God has been pleased to endow & of which I am now possessed I dispose of it in manner & form following—

First the Testimony of my Love & esteem to my well beloved wife Peggy & that her comfort may be promoted by enjoying that property which I purchased to gether I devise to her my Mansion house, Barn, Stable, & all appurtenant buildings together with all that tract of Land lying between Isaac's line & the old school house branch and a line continued from the head of that branch described by the course of said branch untill it strikes the furthest boundary of my plantation to be sole use and behoof during her natural life— Further that she have the whole use of & complete Interest in my two Negroes Neco & Julia during her natural life, and also my two horses & my young mare & colt, also all farming Utensils that shall be deemed necessary for her by the conveniency of housing & the Pastures also my Stock of sheep & hogs & seven head of Cattle to be pointed out by her own choice to be her property during life or as long as she may choose to retain them—

Also I devise to my wife Peggy all & every part of my household furniture to be used at her pleasure & disposed of at her discretion—

Also I devise to my son Isaac my Negro woman Phillis & that she be put into his possession as soon as he crop now in the ground be

Further that she have the whole use of & complete Interest in my two Negroes Nance & Julia during her natural life, and also my two horses & my young mare & colt, also all farming implements that shall be deemed necessary for her by the concurring opinion of herself & the Executors also my Stock of sheep & hogs & seven head of cattle to be pointed out by her own choice to be her property during life or as long as she may choose to retain them—

Next I devise to my wife Peggy all & every part of my household furniture to be used at her pleasure & disposed of at her discretion.

Then I devise to my son Isaac my Negro woman Phillis & that she be put into his possession as soon as the crop now in the ground be gathered.

Then I devise that as much of my Perished property as shall be claimed by my Executors & my wife Peggy is necessary to be retained shall be sold to the best advantage at the discretion of my Executors & that all my just debts be discharged out of the monies thus arising & the residue of the proceeds of the above sale be put into the hands of my

well beloved wife Peggy which I reserve, and to procure to supply her contingent wants & necessities

Item I devise to John Campbell son of Sally Davis my negro child Linus to be delivered to him when he comes to the age of twenty one years

Item I devise that after the death of my wife Peggy the plantation on which I live be divided between my son Isaac and my Daughter Peggy as follows viz by my Spring branch from James tree line to the highest corner of said branch thence continuing a right line directed by the general course of that branch untill it strikes James Wilsons line, that all the land lying on the South side of said line be the property of Isaac his heirs & assigns forever; and that the land lying on the North side of said line be the property of my Daughter Peggy during her natural life & after her decease to descend in fee simple to said Peggys son Alexander Campbell Miller

Item I devise that every species of property whether Real or personal that shall remain at my wifes death & not finally disposed of by any preceding clause be put to fair open sale & that the proceeds of the same be equally divided between my two children Isaac & Peggy -

Finally I do hereby constitute & appoint my true & trusty friends & friends Alexander & James Wilson Esq. the Executors of this my last will & Testament
