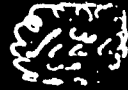

In the name of God Amen. This 4th day of May in the year of
our Lord 1805 I the under Robert being very weak in body
but of sound mind & memory thanks be to the mighty God, he
calling to mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is
appointed for all men once to die, do make & declare this
my last will & Testament in manner & form following, that
is to say principally & first of all, I give & recommend my
soul to God who gave it, and my body I recommend to the
earth to be buried at the discretion of my Executors
nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall
arise the same again by the mighty power of God, &
as touching such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased
God to bless me in this life I give & dispose of
the same in the following manner & form -

Imprimis I give & bequeath to my loving wife Rebeck the plant
ation whereon I now live, with all its appurtenances, with all
the farming tools, all my house creatures, my house hold
stuffs & kegs & all my other property that is now in my
possession during her life or widowhood, to be disposed of
as she thinks fit & right paying all my just debts &c, & in
hereafter mentioned & if she should marry before my young
est child is of age, Then all the property in her hands or
possession to be sold & equally divided between her & the
children then living with her - Item I give & bequeath
to my son William one Dollar - Item I give & bequeath
to my son Samus one Dollar And Lastly I nominate
& appoint my loving wife Rebeck & my two sons
William & Samus to be my sole Executors of this my
last will & Testament and do discontinue & make
void all other wills or Testaments by me formerly made

whether by word or writing & declare this only to be my
last will & Testament in which I have hereunto
set my hand & seal the day & year first above written

In the name of God Amen, I Daniel Robinson of the County
of Mecklenburg & State of N. Carolina being for advanced
in years weak & infirm in body, believing & knowing that all
men must die, think proper while my mind is yet
sound & my memory perfect to dispose of what worldly
property I now possess in manner & form following
Inprimis I will that all my lawful Debts be duly discharged &
paid out of my Estate—Then I will & bequeath to my son
David Robinson his Heirs & assigns forever all that part of
my land on which I now live—Then I will Henrys Com-
missionaries to my son Robert Robinson & that he be under
obligations to let his brother & sisters have a reasonable
use of them—Then I will that all the rest of my books be
equally divided amongst my children like my riding
horses saddles & cash notes or bonds I will & direct to be
equally divided amongst them—Then I will & bequeath
to my grandson Archibald Robinson the tract of land
on which my son has now resided, provided that
Archibald Robinson shall permit my son & his
wife to have possession of said tract of land & enjoy the profits
arising from the cultivation of it during their natural life
Lastly I do hereby revoke all other wills by me made
heretofore & constitute & appoint Andrew Henderson
my son Robert Robinson Executors of this my last will &
Testament, In witness whereof I have hereunto subscribed
my name & affixed my seal this 29th day of November 1805
