to every child half a Dollar to wit Sarah, Peter
Jane, Martin, John, Agnes & David, And to
conclude I Ordain & appoint this my last will
& Testament, Revoking & disannulling all & every
other will or wills, or Testaments heretofore by me made
& written I do constitute & appoint my Sons Math
& James Steel to execute this my last will & Testament
as Witness my hand & seal this 18th of November 180.

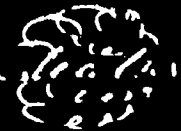
In the Name of God Amen, I Alexander Stewart

& knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die
Do make & Ordain this my last will & Testament that
my principally & first of all I give my soul into the
hands of Almighty God that gave it my body I recommend
to the dead to be buried in a Christian decent manner
at the discretion of my executors & administrators

such worldly estate wherein with it hath pleased God to
bless me with in this life, I give & dispose of the same in the
following manner & form to wit Imprimis I give & bequeath
unto Elizabeth Stewart my dearly beloved wife all that planta-
tion in which I now dwell for & during her natural life
except as herein after excepted, I also give unto her all my
moveable property except as herein after excepted it is also
my will & pleasure that what ever part thereof she can
conveniently spare may be sold & the money arising
out of the sale to be kept by my Executors & laid out for
her use as she shall stand in need, It is further my will
& pleasure that after her death this plantation shall
be sold & the Title made by my Heir at Law & the money
arising out of the sale to be divided in the following
manner to wit the one half to Andrew Stewart my
Grandson & the other half equally between my two
sons John & David. Item I give & bequeath unto
John Stewart my beloved son my Home Bible & great
coat & to his son Alexander my saddle. Item I give
& bequeath unto David Stewart my beloved son my shirt
coat & one book Ambrose looking to Jesus & the compass
of faith, the other books to be divided at the discretion
of my Executors between my two daughters. Item
I give unto Sarah Stewart that house she now resides
in & liberty to clear & cultivate any part of this
plantation as far as ten acres for & during her widowhood
Item I give & bequeath unto Francis Green one Yearling
brown Heifer, it is further my will & pleasure that
after the death of my wife all the remainder of my
estate shall be equally divided between my two sons
& two daughters & Andrew Stewart my Grandson
whom I do hereby constitute & appoint, John & David
Stewart my two sons to be the sole Executors of this
my last will & Testament, And do hereby utterly
revoke & disannul all & every other former will
& Testaments Legacies & Executors by me made written
or bequeathed before confirming this to be my last

Will & Testament. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 10th day of, Decr. 1786, sealed, signed & declared by the said Alexander Stewart in our presence as in & to the said Will & Testament.

In the name of God Amen, I Frederick Ingham of the County of Cheek County & State of Carolina, being in & of full age and perfect mind & memory thanks be to God for it, & therefore calling to mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, I do make & Ordain this my last Will & Testament & first of all I give my soul unto the hands of the Almighty God that give it, & my body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a decent manner at the discretion of my Executors, and as touching worldly affairs wherein it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I give & dispose of the same in the following manner & form as follows, first of all I desire all my lawful debts to be paid & it is my will & pleasure that my loving wife Rachel shall have two thirds of the wheat that is now growing in the Ground, & then one third to my son Fred, this present year, and further it is my desire that my loving wife may have the house & buildings her lifetime & the one third of the Land if needed her lifetime or during her widowhood and at her death or second Marriage I desire my heirs & assigns to have all my Land containing by computation 300 acres between Frederick & I to be divided as follows to begin at the Post Oak John Morris corner on the N^o side of the creek & run across the plantation allowing the Spring run to the west side of the Spring and the Still run to the East side & to be equally divided 150 acres in each part & it is my desire that Rachel should have the better service on the house & I desire the best view & the best of the two sons Rachel & Frederick to pay all my
