In Witness whereof The said John Andrew Henry hath hereunto set hand & affixed his Seal this 15th day of April 1809 -

In the Name of God Amen. I the undersigned of the State of North Carolina Clerk of the County, being in perfect mind & memory Thanks be to God, calling to mind the mortality of the body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, Do make & declare this my last Will & Testament, That is to say principally & first of all, I give & recommend my soul into the hand of Almighty God that gave it, & my body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a decent manner at the discretion of my Children nothing at all tying but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God, had as touching such worldly Estate where with it hath been pleased God to bless me with in this life, I dispose of the same in the following manner First I give & bequeath to my son Andrew Wallace

all that piece or parcel of Land bearing lines with Wm
 & Lewis Griffiths & said Wallace & said supposed
 to contain twenty two acres all my whole bond & duty
 also with my clothing & bed & bedding. Second I give &
 bequeath to my Grandson Charles Wallace
 my young man called by to be his, &c. and lastly I do
 appoint Capt John McNamee & Andrew Wallace to execute
 this my last will & Testament, And I do revoke, disan-
 null & annul all former wills & testaments made by
 me & this to be my last & full Testament. In Witness where of
 I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 9th day of May 1808.
