County & State of Connecticut, being by the affliction of God in a
few days of his life at present, but blessed be God I as yet am possessed
of a sound mind & desirous now very willingly to mend the Mortality
of the body & that it is expected for all men mortal. Do constitute
believe & appoint this to be my last will & Testament in manner & form
following my principles & first of all I give & be unto my wife God
who gave it, and touching my body, I give & be unto her
with I also will & dispose of them in the following manner -
Item I give & be unto my ever loving wife Eleanor Hilde the import
of all my personal Estate after my lawful debts is paid & also the
benefit of the plantation I now live on with all the improvements
for the purpose of Clothing & schooling & raising my several children
to the age of Majority & also the Gray horse & new leather Saddle
over her third part as apportioned. Item I give & be unto my sons Thomas
John, William & Ambrose the plantation I now live on to be equally
divided between them when they come to the age of Twenty one years
and also their equal share of the remaining two thirds of my personal Estate
Item I give & be unto my three daughters Mary, Elizabeth & Martha
each their equal part of all the remainder of my personal Estate, that is
to say after my ever loving wife receives her part, the other two thirds
to be divided into seven equal parts if the Children is there all alive
& if not then in so many as there is then alive & each of my sons to
receive their part as apportioned & each of my daughters their part as apportioned
But if my wife should die, marry again or otherwise not incline to
live on the place & divide my plantation as I now wish, then to be divided

My will & pleasure is that the plantation with all other articles
 there belonging to my Estate be as soon as may be put to public sale
 for the use of my children as aforesaid & my son to be sent to the
 Andover Academy I do constitute & appoint my Trusty & well beloved Cousin
 John Tracy & Robert Fawcett to be my whole & sole Executrix of this my last
 Will & Testament, and I do make, Renewe & Repeal all other will or
 wills by me heretofore made, and do pronounced & declare this & the
 1st day of December 1779 to be my last & desire it to be read in the presence of I have
 hereunto set my hand & seal my seal this 13th of December 1779 -

 calling to mind the uncertainty of my body & knowing that it is appointed
 for all men once to die. Do make & ordain this my last will & testament
 I give & recommend my soul unto Almighty God that gives it. & my
 body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian
 burial at the discretion of Executors hereafter mentioned and as
 Touching such worldly estate as it has pleased God to bless me with in
 this life. I give & devise & dispose of the same in the following manner
 Item, I first I do will & allow all my lawful debts to be discharged
 out of my personal Estate. Then I do will & bequeath to my dearly
 beloved wife Mary Harrison one third of my personal Estate toge
 ther with my bed ware & her own saddle also her living of the plan
 tation & the use of the house during her widowhood, likewise three
 Cows & one Sheep for the use & support of my family also
 Two plow horses & three set of horse gear. Also my large house
 young horses & Dicks for the use & support of my family.
 Then I also give & bequeath to my son Isaac Willimardishill that
 plantation which he now lives on & a deed of conveyance to be
 made him by my executors. Also I will & bequeath all the lands
 I have possessed of to my three sons James, John & Elias to be equally
