In the name of God amen. I Andrew Dunn of the County of Warklebury
& State of Massachusetts, being very sick & weak in body but of perfect mind
& memory thankes be given unto God, setting unto mind the mortaliety
of my body & knoweing that it is appoynted unto all men once
to die. Do make & ordain this my last will & Testament, which
is to say principally & first of all I give & recommend my soul
unto God that gave it. My body I recommend to the earth to be
buried in a decent Christian burial at the discretion of my execu-
tors nothing dreading but at the General resurrection I shall
receive the same again by the mighty power of God; and as
providing such worldly estate wherewithal as has pleased God to bless
me in this life; I give & ordain to dispose of the same in the following
manner & form - First I give & bequeath to my Eldest brother Robert
Dunn for the sume good & affection shew to him one hundreth
thousand Pounds together with one half of the money which is now in
the hands of Mr Salle for the land which he now has or shall have
half of my hundred thousand pounds together with the half of my house
Kiddle excepting the roome named Kiddle; also I give land
the greatest part to my well beloved brother James Dunn the place or
station or place of land lying on the Creek with the other half
the other half of the said money lying in the hands of Mr Salle.

The half of the Stock & household furniture with half of the necessary tools
all this except the under named legacies. I also give unto my
Sister Betty Garrison ten Shillings, & I also give my Brother John
Dunn ten Shillings. I likewise give the bequest to Charles Thompson
ten Shillings. Likewise I give the residue unto Barbara Brewster
Shillings. I also give the bequest to my Sister Peggy Hinsdale ten
Shillings. I give unto Eli Reed which was lawfully sworn to
by his Master a Master Barber ten Shillings.

I likewise constitute make & ordain Robert Dunn my eldest
Brother & James Dunn Esquire Esquire, their I do hereby entirely
disinherit & make & disannul his & Henry's other former Testaments
by me in my life before named, Reliving & reposing the same
to this to be my last Will & Testament, the witness whereof I
have hereunto set my Seal this 8th day of March in the year of
our Lord 1813

of my household & kitchen furniture worth one hundred & Eighty Dollars.
5th I give to my Daughter Mary Pleasant my Mace & the other half of my
household & kitchen furniture. 6th I give to my grand daughter Peggy Douglass
daughter of my son George Douglass one & half thousand has more in his
possession. 7th I give to my son Joseph Douglass the rest of my cattle also
I tell my son Joseph to sell my house near my son George & Miller at a reasonable
price & divide the money between them & his wife
