 following circumstances First That if by length my wife Mary -
 should die, that then I do require my Executors to dispose of the
 whole of my property real & personal then on hand & execute titles
 for the same giving a reasonable credit for the time of sale, & of
 said Estate to make an equal division between my wife & children
 then & there a like, & it is also my desire that my children in their
 case should be bound out by good tender men such as my Executors
 should approve of. Also that if at any future period it be tho't
 more advantageous to the interest of my wife & my said children
 to dispose of the land I do hereby direct my Executors to dispose
 of the same & execute titles provided that the sale be agreeable to
 my wife, other wise if none of the above cases should happen
 but that my wife & my said children should remain together
 agreeable to my desire, that when my poor body comes of age
 that my Executors would make choice of them good & discreet
 freeholders to govern the Estate then on hand real & personal
 when done there then shall be a division of a part to them
 which division shall be in proportion of the divisions of
 the above mentioned persons. Lastly I do appoint my trusty
 friends Nathaniel Abraham & Alexander Davis my Executors
 working all other wills & Testaments by me made in Kentucky
 to have I do hereby give my hand & seal this 20th day of March 1798

In the name of God Amen, I Andrew Rice of the County of
 County & State of Kentucky being sick & weak in body, do hereby
 make my last will & testament in manner & form as follows
 To dispose of both my worldly Estate it has pleased a kind Providence
 to bless me in this life with in manner & form following
Imprimis I will that all my just debts & personal expenses be paid
 out of my estate. Next I will & bequeath to my beloved wife
 the maintenance of the plantation on which I live & the

beneficial way of the house I now live in during his natural life
Also I bequeath unto his son feather bed & furniture & whatever part
of the household capitulated & that these furniture that they choose
to keep or retain, I further bequeath unto his my Said Horse
known by the name of black with hundred all & byells & also
three cows the having his choice of this Stock, then I give and
bequeath to my son John the use of the money now due from
him to me being at present the sum of thirty six dollars untill
his son Andrew arrives at the age of twenty one years when
it is to become the property of said Andrew, then I give & bequeath
to my Daughter Ann McClay her one staff given part of the
same Quality as her Sister, then I will & bequeath to my son
Andrew Twenty two dollars which sum is now due from
him to me being the price of the wooden work of a wagon
for which I have already paid him, also I will that the
Iron be replaced which I borrowed of him being about two
hundred & seventy weight, then I give & bequeath to my daughter
Jane the black mare and the year old colt, one feather
bed & furniture & the one half of the remainder of the Household
& that these furniture - then I give & bequeath to my son Reed the
sum of Eighty Dollars to purchase a horse & the part of sixty dollars
to purchase tools & then to set up his trade & it is my will that the
said sums be delivered to him before or against the first
of September next, then I give & bequeath to my son Thomas the
plantation on which I now live to him his heirs or assigns, save
with this reserve that my two daughters Jane & Elizabeth have
their Maintenance of it during the Time of their Living in a
single State together with the part of the live Stock in this In-
strument bequeathed to them, & do also further give & bequeath
to my Said son Thomas the following farming utensils viz
two plows the black horses, one Ox, one Mallow, two hoes, two
pairs of plowing gear complete together with the shot gun
As to the remainder of my Stock of Cattle I will & distribute
them as follows viz I bequeath to my son Reed two steers he
having his choice, to my son Thomas I also bequeath two
the remainder of my Stock I will to be equally divided between
my daughters Jane & Elizabeth

My flock of sheep I dispose of & bequeath as follows viz to my daughter
 Ann & my son Andrew to each I will give leave & leave to be admitted
 to them within the space of 2 years from the date of this instrument
 the remainder of the flock shall to be equally divided between
 my wife & my two daughters Jane & Elizabeth each sharing a like
 share I give & bequeath to my daughter Jane & Elizabeth one
 Green pasture - but to the intention of my wife by property
 not heretofore granted or bequeathed it is my will that it be sold
 at public Auction & that the Monies arising therefrom all

Concerning all the foregoing legacies & bequests in this instrument
 be equally divided between my wife, my son Andrew and my
 daughters Jane & Elizabeth each sharing a like -

Lastly, I do hereby nominate & appoint my son John Nea toge-
 ther with James Chalmers & William Walker Executors of this my
 last will & testament hereby revoking & making void & void
 all other wills & bequests heretofore by me made confirm-
 ing this to be my last will & testament in witness
 whereunto I have signed my hand & seal at this 10th day of May 1844
