very sick & weak in body but of perfect mind & memory
thankes to grace unto God. Wherefore calling to mind
the mortality of my body & knowing that it is ap-
pointed for all men once to die do make & ordain
this my last will & Testament. That is to say pri-
mately & first of all I give & recommend my灵魂 to the
hands of Almighty God who gave it, & my body
I recommend to the earth to be buried in a honest
-man like & decent manner at the discretion of
my executors nothing desiring but at the general
Resurrection I shall receive the same again by
the mighty power of God, and as touching such
worldly Estate wherewithal it hath pleased God to
bless me in this life I give devise & dispose of the same
in the manner & form following. (That is to say).

I wish I will that all those debts & duties which I owe in
right or conscience to any man or person or persons
whatsoever shall be well & truly accounted paid or otherwise
to be paid within convenient time after my decease by
my executors here after named. Item I give & bequeath
unto my beloved daughter Charged Skinner a black
bay horse named Diamond & a black & white Heifer
with calfe named Betty & the best bed & its furniture
from half of the paster, but which she is to make up
Thirty pounds to be by her or her heirs given to my
youngest son Andrew Riner when he is twenty
one years of age. & to bring him up & give him as good
education as her opportunity will admit—
Item I also bequeath unto my beloved daughter
Sarah Skinner a young horse named Duke & a brown
Heifer named Brown & a bed & its furniture and the
remaining half of the paster also two other heifers
the one black & the other Red with a white face
out of which she or her heirs is cause to make

up thirty pounds to be by her or those given to my beloved
 Daughter Mary at the age of eighteen years to bring her up
 & give her as good Education as her Opportunities will allow
 Item I also bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Elizabeth
Hinson two Cows, two Sheep & a black Chest
 Item I also give & bequeath unto my beloved son David
Hinson all that Message Plantation or Part of Land which
 I now possess & a black bay horse named Golly, thet of which
 he or his heirs are to pay unto my beloved son John Hinson
 the sum of Sixty pounds North Carolina currency where he living
 at the age of Twenty one years & in case of Johns decease
 before he is of age his part when due is to be paid unto
 my youngest son Alexander Hinson also there is a Horse
 which I bequeath to John. Item I also bequeath unto
 my beloved son Andrew Hinson a bay Mare named J. with
 & a Sheep. Likewise I do make constitute ordain to
 appoint Alexander Stewart, John Weeks & John Wyllie to be
 the only & sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament &
 I do hereby declare disallow & disown all & every
 other former Testamente, Wills & Legacies bequeath'd
 Executors leg. me in any wise before this time. named
 willed & bequeathed, Ratifying & confirming this to no
 other to be my last Will & Testament. In witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day & year above
 written signed, sealed, published, pronounced & declared by
 the said Andrew Hinson as his last Will & Testament in
