In the name of God Amen. I Anne Wilson being sick of body but of sound & disposing mind & memory, do make & declare & constitute this to be my last will & Testament.
Firstly, I Will that all my Just Debts be paid by my Executors hereafter named - Secondly, I Will & allow my beloved son Robert Wilson to have fifteen dollars out of note of hand which he has in his possession payable to me from Josiah Allen & Joseph Blackwood Esq for the sum of sixty dollars, as a compensation for the trouble I have been to him in this my illness 3^{rdly} I Will & allow my beloved daughter Ann Todd all my beds & furniture of every kind, all my clothes my treasure, & every article of household & kitchen furniture, also all my cattle & hay to be for her use & at her disposal. 4^{thly} I Will & allow my beloved son John Wilson to have Twenty dollars out of the above mentioned note now in the possession of my son Robert Wilson & due to me from Josiah Allen & Joseph Blackwood Esq. which said Twenty dollars I allow to be paid to Interest to Interest & the note renewed from time to time every year, & said Twenty dollars & the interest arising from it be paid to him by my Executors hereafter to be named when he arrives at the age of twenty years

Fifthly I will & allow the balance due on the above mentioned notes after paying off the two above mentioned legacies together with about forty dollars due me from Thomas Henry be applied to the payment of my debts & if there should be any surplus money after the payment of my debts as aforesaid I will & allow it to be paid to my Daughter Ann Todd by my Executor hereafter to be named—

Sixthly I do hereby declare, appoint & constitute my trust friend William Hester Esq. my whole & sole Executor of this my last will & Testament, hereby revoking and disannulling all former & other wills making & appointing this & this only as my last will & Testament— Given under my hand & seal this 27th day of Aug^r 1819 Signed sealed & published the day & date above written in presence of us who all signed in presence of each other
