die; Do make & declare this my last Will & Testament that is
to say principally I give of all I give & recommend my soul

Christian manner at the discretion of my Executors, and
as for such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to
bless me with, I give & dispose of in the following manner
viz first that all my lawful debts be paid

Item I will I bequeath to my son Elias all I singular the tract &
parcel of Land whereon I now live, and I also will and
bequeath to my Daughter Ann Taylor all I singular the tract
& parcel of Land whereon Frederick Taylor now lives & also
I will & bequeath a tract & parcel of Land to my son John
now lying in the hand of Col. Thomas King now living in
the State of Tennessee Hawkins County, and all the rest of
my property such as Horses Cattle household furniture
plantation tools, Carpenter Tools, &c. I will I bequeath to be
and to be equally divided among my Children except one
woman's Saddle to be taken out, for my Daughter Mary Ann
&c. For the Executors of my estate I do appoint my son
John & Samuel Downs. Dated this 3^d of January 1806
