yfirst of all I give & recommend my soul into the hands of
Almighty God that gave it. My body I recommend to the
Earth to be buried in a decent Christian burial at the discretion
of my executors nothing doubting but at the
general resurrection I shall receive the same again by
the mighty power of God and as touching such worldly
Estates wherewithal I have pleased God to bless me in this life
I give devise & dispose of the same in the following manner
yours First I give & bequeath to Eliza with my deare
intendes before the said Eliza her selfe five pounds lawful money
of Carolina in gold or silver to be raised & paid
out of my estate together with the gray mare & colt. be-
longing to the same & a side saddle my bed & bedstee the
vigrate of my metal pds that is to say one iron pot, & dish
of pewter & likewise three plates of delft a half a dozen
of plates of delft two milch cows very strong & wise each
a Neaper according to her own joy to choose the same my
place called the new meadow in the County of Bristol; .

kind now growing in my field. Likewise a spinning
wheel on the west of all my man. & C. goods
secondly. My pleasure is to be sold two months after
my death & then the rest of my valuable goods & chattels
is likewise to be sold all for gold or silver money my
children are all to every one of them to be taught &
educated in the true Christian Religion
especially my sons are to be employed to some honest
trade & so to continue & diversify Lastly I constitute
make & ordain Wm. Clark House & Daniel Farrow
of executors of this my last will & Testament, and I
do hereby utterly disclaim, revoke & disannul all
I every other former Testaments, wills, figures beginning
& executors by me in anywise before named written &
or, or attested. Ratifying & confirming this to be
my last will & Testament In witness whereof I have here
unto set my hand this 29th day of May in the year
of our Lord 1786.
