



Item I give & bequeath to my beloved Sister Violet Young the Benjamin Davidson the West side of my plantation beginning on the Creek at the mouth of a branch known by the name of the old Spring branch running up the course of said branch to the house standing into the main highway road to an old road that leads to Allison Woods, thence up the said way on road to my line with this reserve that said Benjamin Davidson when he gets possession of said land on any part thereof shall pay to my beloved sister Mary Polk's eldest son Thomas Polk the sum of forty pounds.

Item I give & bequeath to my beloved David Wilson's son Benjamin Wilson all the remainder of the plantation whereon I now live being the East side to him possession when he arrives at the age of Twenty one years -

Item I give & bequeath to my beloved brother Robert Wilson one negro man named Warick; Item I give & bequeath to my beloved brother David Wilson the sum of forty pounds to be raised & levied out of my estate -

Item I give & bequeath to my beloved sister Mary's daughter Maria Polk the sum of forty pounds to be raised and levied out of my estate - Item I give & bequeath to my beloved brother Samuel Wilson's oldest daughter Mary of forty pounds to be raised & levied out of my estate -

Item I give & bequeath to my said brother Samuel's daughter Violet Wilson the sum of forty pounds to be raised and levied out of my estate - Item I give & bequeath to my beloved niece Rebecca Henderson the sum of forty pounds to be raised & levied out of my estate.

Item I give & bequeath to my friend Jonathan Polk's oldest daughter Mary Polk the sum of forty pounds to be raised & levied out of my estate.

Item I give & bequeath to my said friend Jonathan Polk's daughter Peggy Polk the sum of forty pounds to be raised & levied out of my estate - Item It is further my will

that if the brain'd boy Dickey Coover should continue some my wife & Margaret till he arrives to the age of thirteen that he be allowed the sum of fifteen pounds to buy in one year schooling & furnish him out

Also a further sum of forty pounds  
 he arrives to the age of Twenty one years to be paid  
 Levied out of my estate. Item It is my will that my  
 wearing apparel be equally divided between my bro  
David & Samuel Wilson; Item It is further my will that  
 all the unappropriated part of my estate be sold my  
 Just debts paid & such of the Legacies as are of age  
 be paid their respective Legacies, & such of the Legats  
 as are not of age their respective Legacies to be pu  
 out to Interest untill the arriv to the age of Twenty  
 one years the males & Eighteen the females -

Item Further it is my will that if any thing remains  
 after the above distribution it be equally divided  
 between my wife Margaret & my sister Margaret  
 Davidson my sister Sarah McConnell & my sister  
 Lylly Connor - Item It is further my will that if  
 there should not be enough to pay the above Legats  
 that each Legatee receive an Equal share according  
 to their Legacies, with this exception that my wife  
 Margaret receive her full Legacy of Twenty five Pounds

And Lastly It is my will that my worthy friends Hugh  
 Foreman & William Henderson be & I do hereby  
 nominate constitute & appoint them the said Hugh  
 Foreman & William Henderson whole & sole Executors  
 of this my last will & Testament, and do hereby  
 utterly revoke disallow & disannul all other and  
 former wills, Legacies & bequests by me in any man  
 heretofore made. Ratifying & confirming this & no  
 other to be my last will & Testament. In Testimony  
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 12<sup>th</sup>  
 day of July AD 1799 -
