In the name of God Amen, I Anne Wilson being sick of body but of sound & disposing mind & memory, do make & declare & constitute this to be my last will & Testament.
First, I Will that all my Just Debts be paid by my Executors hereafter named - Secondly, I Will & allow my beloved son Robert Wilson to have fifteen dollars out of Note of hand which he has in his possession payable to me from Josiah Allen & Joseph Blackwood Esq for the sum of Seventy dollars, as a compensation for the trouble I have been to him in this my illness 3rd I Will & allow my beloved daughter Annie Todd all my beds & furniture of every kind, all my clothes my trousseau, & every article of household & kitchen furniture, also all my Cattle & Hays to be for her use & at her disposal. 4th I Will & allow my beloved son John Wilson to have Twenty dollars out of the above mentioned Note now in the possession of my son Robert Wilson & due to me from Josiah Allen & Joseph Blackwood Esq. which said Twenty dollars I allow to be paid to Interest to Interest & the Note renewed from time to time every year, & said Twenty dollars & the Interest arising from it be paid to him by my Executors hereafter to be named when he arrives at the age of twenty years
