it shall please God to call, do therefore make this my last will & testa-
ment, this second day of August in the year of our Lord 1785, first
principally I recommend my Soul unto Almighty God who grant
unto me, & my body to be buried in a Christian like manner according
to the direction of my Deceased hereafter named, And for the settling
of my Estate & such goods as has pleased God to bless my late deceased
husband & mine with, I Give & Bequeath in manner & form hereafter
mentioned, first I will that my funeral charges be paid & I will
I will that my two daughters Sophia & Susan shall have
their share from my husband their father that I bear upon me shall be
paid to them out of my things — I Give & Bequeath unto my son
Philip a black Cow with a white head, & a bed, & after my decease my
son Philip is to take my youngest son John together to build for my son
up — I Give & Bequeath unto my son Jacob the old mare, & all the
Iron pot, a hugh, two new broad hoes, all the woodden Vessels, large & small
one plow, a black Cow & six calves & all the hogs, the Windmill all the
Linnis & the Iron lock Horse, Philip & Jacob is to keep together
them both, & Jacob is to give a cow to each Henry & Jacob when they
come of age — Also, I give my saddle unto my daughter Catherine
also the hope that I have of her — Also, I Give my Daughter

Resigned my last will & testament I give unto my Daughter Mary my Kettle & Sewing board. I give unto my second youngest Girl, Septim & her annual I give all my Pearls & La. shells & Shimmer also ambrosia 100 & don't know but I give unto her with a praying board without feet between them. Then I give unto Anna Margaret the young man which she is to have when the two girls shall be able to marry which said part of the young man Tobias is to raise up for Henry his Brother. Also my large Iron pot, I give unto Anna Margaret. Then I will that my daughters Catherine take Septim to bring her up to her own house & when she is of age or desired to give her two loves and a bed. Then I will that my daughter Rosemary shall take her annual & two loves & when she is of age or desired to give her two loves & a bed and Catherine & Rosemary is to have all my goods between them. Then my large Copper Kettle is to be priced & the money equal to be shared amongst the before said named children & my few apparel is to be equally shared amongst my above named daughters. Lastly I give my bed unto my son in law daughter Elizabeth. And unto this my last will & Testament I do constitute & appoint my two beloved sons Philip & Tobias Keepers & my lawful Executors. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this day & year just above written.
