 the State of North Carolina being in a weak State of body but of clear mind & memory do this 27th day of March in the year of our Lord
 1792 make this my last will & Testament in the following manner
 To my son David Caldwell I Give & bequeath the all that tract of Land
 containing 203 Acres whereon he now dwells with all rights thereunto
 belonging to him & his Heirs forever, & also one Negro man named Abram
 & one black man named Florida & one two years old black Colt.
 To my son Charles Caldwell I Give & bequeath the plantation whereon
 I now dwell containing 272 Acres adjoining the former lands with all
 rights thereof to him & his Heirs forever & also one Negro boy named Ham-
 mond to my daughter Martha I Give & bequeath all that tract of Land
 whereon Dr. Thomas Donnell, formerly dwelt containing 127 Acres with
 all the rights & appurtenances thereof to her & her Heirs forever & also one horse
 named Roger & a mare named Leticia All my Cattle except two Steers
 of the best & two Cows which I intend to be sold I intend to be equally
 divided between my son David & daughter Martha, and all my
 Farming Utensils I Give to my son David except one large plow
 which I Give to my daughter Martha, Also all my wheat & Ory in the
 ground I Give two thirds thereof to my son David & one third thereof to
 daughter Martha. Also to my son David & daughter Martha I Give & bequeath all my house hold furniture
 & also several Sheep & Hogs to be equally divided between them
 To my daughter Susan I Give & bequeath ten pounds in hard money
 all my other property or Cash except what has been above
 mentioned, after my Just debts & funeral charges are paid
 I Give & bequeath to my son David. And I do hereby
 declare constitute & appoint my son David Caldwell &
 John Allison to be my Sole Executors of this my last will
 & Testament, And I do hereby utterly revoke & disannul
 all my former wills & bequests, proving & declaring this
 & none other to be my last will & Testament to the State herein
 above mentioned.

all the rights & appurtenances thereof to her this His former Black man
named Roger & a mare named Kate All my Cattle (except two steers
of the best & two cows which I allow to be sold) I allow to be equally
divided between my son David & daughter Martha, and all my
farming utensils I give to my son David except one large plow
which I give to my daughter Martha, also all my wheat & Rye in the
ground I give two thirds thereof to my son David & one third thereof to
his daughter Martha also to my son David to
daughter Martha I give & bequeath all my house hold furniture
flax seed sheep & Hogs to be equally divided between them
In charge of which I give & bequeath ten pounds in hard money
all my other property or Cattle except what has been above
mentioned, after my just debts & funeral charges are paid
I give & bequeath to my son David - And I do hereby
reclaim constitute & appoint my son David Executor of this my last will
& Testament, and do hereby utterly revoke & disannul
all my former wills & bequests pronouncing & declaring this
& none other to be my last will & Testament to the state having
above mentioned given under my hand & seal on the same
day & year above mentioned

by the said Charles Caldwell to be his last
will & Testament & to be of record date
