

In the Name of God Amen. I Charles Caldwell of Mecklenburg County the
 State of North Carolina being in a weak State of body, but of sound mind do
 solemnly witness & say that I do this 27th day of October in the year of our Lord
 1792 in health my last will & Testament in the following manner.
 To my son David Caldwell & I give & bequeath all that tract of Land
 containing 203 acres, whereon he now dwelleth with all rights thereto
 belonging to him this his forever. Also one Negro man named Libious
 & one black woman named Florida. These two goes to black Pott.
 " so my son Charles Caldwell I give & bequeath the plantation whereon
 I now dwelt containing 272 acres adjoining the former lands with all
 rights thereof to him this his forever. Also one Negro boy named Ham -
 chid to my daughter Martha. I give & bequeath all that tract of land
 whereon Doell Thomas Donville, formerly dwelt containing 127 acres with
 all the rights & appurtenances there of to her this his forever also one house
 named Roger & a mare no mule late. All my cattle except two steers
 of the best & two horses which I determine to be sold. I then to be equally
 divided between my son David & daughter Martha and all my
 farming utensils & gear to my son David except one large plow
 which I give to my Daughter Martha, Also all my wheat & Oats in the
 ground I give her third share of. To my son David from third thereof
 ten bushels of Corn to my Daughter Martha Also to my son David the
 Proportionate share I give & bequeath all my household furniture
 That is said sheep & Hogs to be equally divided between them
 To Margaret Brown I give & bequeath ten pounds in hard money
 all my other property or Cash except what her here above
 mentioned, After my just debts & funeral charges are paid
 I give & bequeath to my son David. And I do hereby
 before witnesses & appoint my son David Caldwell &
 John Allison to be my sole Executrix of this my last will
 & Testament, And do hereby entirely revoke & disannul
 all my former wills & instruments previous to & including this
 & name after to be my last will & Testament to the state herein
 above named Mecklenburg Co., NC Wills 1783-1844 seal on the same.

belonging to him & his Heirs forever, & also one Negro man named Libe and

Also my son Charles Caldwell I give & bequeath the plantation whereon
I now dwell containing 272 acres adjoining the Apawash land with all
rights thereto to him & his Heirs forever. Also one Negro boy named Ham -
and to my daughter Martha I give & bequeath all that tract of land
whereon Doctl Thomas Donnale, formerly dwelt containing 127 acres with
all the rights & appurtenances thereto to her & her Heirs forever also one horse
named Roger & a mare no. m. m. late All my Cattl (Except two Steers
of the best & two lambs which I intend to be sold) I intent to be equally
divided between my son David & daughter Martha, and all my
farming Utensils I give to my son David except one large plow
which I give to my Daughter Martha, Also all my wheel & Oye in the
ground I give two thirds thereof to my son David & one third thereof to
my Daughter Martha to my Daughter Martha also to my son David &
Daughter Martha I give & bequeath all my household furniture
Also two old Sheep & Hogs to be equally divided between them
In a hog yard where I give & bequeath ten pounds in hard money
all my other property or Cattl except what has been above
mentioned, After my just debts & funeral charges are paid
I give & bequeath to my son David And I do hereby
herein constitute & appoint my son David Caldwell &
John Allison to be my sole Executrix of this my last will
& Testament, And do hereby entirely revoke & disannul
all my former wills, & I witness, pronouncing & declaring this
& none other to be my last will & Testament to the abovesigned
above mentioned given under my hand & seal on the same
day & year above mentioned
