Item It is my desire that the rest & residue be purchased at discretion
of my Executors & given up there be any remainder of my Estate
it is my desire that it be equally divided among my four
children here after named viz Eliza West Dunlap, Rebecca Parks
& Martha Davis, Charles Burns & David Burns their children
Item I do hereby constate & affirm my son in law William
Dunlap, Charles Burns & David Burns Executors of this my
last Will and hereby revoking & cancelling all former Wills
whatever Publishing & declaring this to be my last Will &
Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
And this 25th day of March in the year of our Lord 1821 and
of the Independence of the United States of America the 37th
Signed sealed published & acknowledged by
Alexander Burns the above named Testator
as & for his last will & Testament in the

22 In the name of God amen I Charles Cook of the County of
Northumberland State of New-Jersey being of sound & perfect
mind & memory blessed be God do in this third day of August
in the year of our Lord 1821 do make & publish this my last
will & testament in manner following that is to say
First I give & bequeath my soul to God that gave it to
my body to be buried at the discretion of my Executors
2dly I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Polly a bed & furniture
& dress and an equal division with my Daughter Belong
Cornelia except one hundred dollars which I wish my
Daughter to have for the purpose of marriage
3dly I give & bequeath to my Daughter Helen a certain number

divided with my wife Polly last if my Daughter Cornelia
Should die before the time of age then my wife Polly is to
have the whole during her life and at the death of my wife
my Daughter Cornelia's part is to be equally divided
between my brothers & sisters, I further wish my Executors
to purchase one or more young Negroes with the money
that may arise from the division of my Estate, & said
Negroes to be held over to my daughters p[er]petuity
And I hereby make & ordain my worthy friends & acquaintances
Persons of my brother Wm Cook Executors of this my last will
& Testament, In witness whereof the said Cook doth
here to this my last will & Testament set my hand & seal
the day of Yeeb come written.

Seimus sealed published & declared by the said
Cook doth leave the Testator to his last will &
Testament in the presence of us who were
present at the time of signing & sealing hereunto.
