North Carolina. } In the name of God Amen. I Henry Harris
Hertford County } of the County & Province aforesaid being in God
Health of body & sound of mind & memory thanks be given to God
therefore calling to mind the Mortality of the body & that it is appointed
for all men once to die, Do make & ordain that my last Will & Testament
that is to say principally & first of all I give & bequeath the my precious
Soul unto God who gave it, And my mortal body I recommend to
earth to be buried in a decent manner at the discretion of my Ex^{rs}
Nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive
the same reunited to my Soul by the Mighty power of God. And
having such worldly Goods as God hath been pleased to bless me
with in this life, I give devise & bequeath the same in the fol
lowing manner & form— first I allow all my lawfull debts
to be paid— Secondly I give & bequeath to my eldest daughter
Martha five Shillings Sterling. Thirdly I bequeath to said daughter
eldest daughter James Harris twenty five pounds p^{re} to be paid
her as soon as she is married, & also I bequeath to the above
Martha second son Charles Edward Harris twenty five pounds
to be paid him as soon as he comes of age. 4th I give & bequeath
to my 2^d son Robert all that tract of land lying on the west
side of Broad River on both sides of Newn Creek in S^c Carolina
& 150 acres joining said tract & the negro boy back with one
of my breeding negroes. 5th I bequeath to son Thomas

one half of my bearing Apprentice - 6^{thly} I bequeath to my two
daughters Mary & Ann & Rebecca to each of them five
hundred pounds, 7^{thly} I leave & bequeath to my son James one
thousand pounds & give to be kept in the hands of my son James
to pay the Interest of it yearly to James or his heirs or to any
of him & his must be any of his Mother he chooses. When
he dies, I Order said hundred pounds to be equally di-
vided amongst all my Children to my first wife - 8^{thly}
I bequeath to my sons Samuel & Charles all that Tract of Land
on which I now live with that Tract on Lot 6 & 7 The Neck Hill
& also one hundred & fifty acres on the big run west of said hill
likewise that land I purchased from John Mitchell lying
on the Millry or back run & that forty acres I bought of Ad-
am - 9^{thly} Give & bequeath to the issue of my son Thomas
Lawfully begot all that Tract of Land I bought of Rob^t Davis
lying on Broadlam creek containing six hundred acres
to be equally divided amongst them all when the younger
come to age According to Law their Mother to have her in-
tertainment off it during her life or widowhood - 10^{thly} I bequeath to
my well beloved wife Elizabeth one third of all my personal
Estate during her life or continuance a widow & if she marries,
that she to have one good feather bed & necessary cloathing & the
value of all the horses belonging to the Estate Samuel more the
issue excepted & twenty pounds Price & the negro woman Dinah
during her life & when she dies the said Dinah & her issue to
go to my two sons Samuel & Charles. - 11^{thly} I give & bequeath
to my two sons Samuel & Charles all & every part of my Estate
not before mentioned & if either of them dies before they come
to age their part is to go to the surviving Brother & if they both die
in their non age their parts is to be equally divided Among
all my children; And Lastly I do hereby nominate my de-
ar wife Elizabeth & my well beloved sons Robert Harris & George
& Alexander Executors of this my last Will & Testament, testifying and
confirming this & no other to be my last Will & Testament, the witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 3^d day of May 1742
