rest of the property to be sold & divided amongst the Heirs.
And I leave James Todde as Executor of this my will in trust for the
intents & purposes in this my will contained in witness whereof I
the said Robert Danner have set my last will & Testament, set my
hand & seal the day & year above written

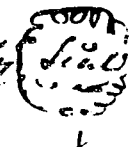
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In the name of God Amen, I Daniel Dehuety of the State of North
Carolina & County of Mecklenburg, being in health & sound mind
& memory, and calling to mind that it is appointed, for all men to
die & after death the judgment when we are to render an account to
Almighty God for all the deeds done in the body therefore do
make appoint & order this my last will & Testament; And first
I give my soul to Almighty God who gave it, and leave my body
to be buried at the discretion of my Executors in the full assurance
of receiving the same again at the Resurrection of the last day.
And of the property & good things of this life, I leave & bequeath in
the following manner - First I will that all my lawfull debts
be paid in a convenient time after my death; Second I will
my Household furniture to my unmarried Daughters Elizabeth
& Phoebe, I leave & bequeath with my house & the east end of my
plantation to make a living on as long as the remaining single
or less proper to live on it - Third I will my Daughters the use
of the Negroes for the term of one year & farming utensils & at
the end of one year my Negroes to be equally divided by va-
luation by three impartial men betwixt my daughters
Elizabeth, Hannah, Phoebe, I leave & bequeath my daughter Rebecca
two children Mary & Manhope. Rebecca's children are to

have our Childs part be twist them both, And I leave my single
Daughters all my Black Horse Cows Sheep & Hogs, And I leave my
books to be equally divided among my Children -- I write
that at the end of one year after my decease that all my lands be
divided equally according to quality & each of my Daughters
to have an equal share -- I do hereby Appoint John Galmon
& John Montgomery to execute this my last Will & Testament
And do by these presents revoke & disannul all wills heretofore
made by me, And declare this to be my last Will & Testament
As Witness whereunto I have set my hand & affixed my seal
in presence of this 9th day of November 1822

in this transitory world & that it is appointed for all men once, die

following that is to say first & chiefly I recommend my soul to the hands of
my Creator & Almighty God who gave it hoping through the merits and
Intercession of my blessed Saviour & Redeemer Jesus Christ to enjoy a
place of rest with him in Immortality, And my body I commend to the
Earth to be decently buried in a Christian manner at the discretion
of my Executors hereafter named, And as to what worldly estate He
hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I dispose of in manner following
primit. I order that my just debts & funeral expenses be paid &
discharged by my Executors.

I Give & devise all & singular my plantations & Tracts of land
whereon I now live in the said County of said one containing
by estimation one hundred & five acres the other one hundred &
thirty four acres together with all the buildings Improvements &
Appurtenances thereunto belonging unto my dear, just son Joseph
Everett his heirs & assigns forever
