farming Utensils, my household & Kitchen furniture & all outstanding
debts due to me, & all or any property belonging to me not herein
before mentioned, She paying out of the same the following sum viz
to my Sons James, John & George to each of them one dollar if they
come to receive the same within 12 Months after my death, and
to my Daughter wife to William Clephane one Dollar & to my former
son in law Henry Hasgett one Dollar. - And lastly I do hereby nominate
and my Daughter Janet the sole Executrix of this my last Will
& Testament, hereby revoking all former Wills by me heretofore
made, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed
my seal this 16th day of January 1806.

& that it is appointed for all men once to die, do the 20th day of October
in the year of Our Lord 1806, make & appoint this my last Will
& Testament in the manner & form following - 1st. I will that all
my just debts be honestly paid by my executors herein after
named - And I will bequeath to my beloved wife Jane all
my personal estate, also my plantation herein & to all other
belongings (except those bequeathed by my son James Finley) as
I will & bequeath to my sons Michael & Peter herein before named
one ten Shillings. And to my Daughter Sarah Bigham, also
Berryhill & Jonathan Stephenson I will & bequeath each ten
Shillings - And to my son James Freeman I will bequeath

and divide the plantation whereon I now live in the following
manner viz That my wife shall have & possess at above mentioned
also that he the said farms Freeman shall give to my step
daughter Elizabeth Hayes, all the land belonging to said plan-
tation which lies on the N side of the wagon Road leading from
Blackville to the first bridge fords on Catawba or otherwise to
pay her eighty Dollars or forty pounds in the term of two years
after my decease. - And I appoint my son James Freeman
& John Hayes Executors & my wife Jane Executrix of this my last
will & Testament, and I do hereby rescind all former Wills &
Testaments by me made. In witness whereof I have hereunto
