

with forty acres adjoining the same to him & his heirs forever in fee simple - And as to my son Charles & my Daughter Martha wife to Daniel Roberson having given them formerly & make no further provision for them in this my will; I likewise leave unto my Daughter Jennet all my Stock of Horses, Cattle & Hogs & plantation tools and farming utensils, my household & kitchen furniture & all but standing debts due to me, & all or any property belonging to me not herein before mentioned, she paying out of the same the following sum viz to my sons James, John & George to each of them one dollar if they come to receive the same within 12 months after my decease, and to my Daughter wife to William Cheple one Dollar & to my former son in law Henry Hargett one Dollar. - And lastly I do hereby nominate my Daughter Jennet the sole executrix of this my last will & Testament, hereby revoking all former Wills by me heretofore made, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 16th day of January 1806 -

and declare the plantation whereon I now live in the following
manner viz That my wife shall have & possess at above mentioned
also that the said James Freeman shall give to my step
daughter Elizabeth Hays, all the land belonging to said plan
tation which lies on the N side of the wagon Road leading from
Charlotte to the first asize fords on Catawba or otherwise to
pay her eighty Dollars or forty pounds in the term of two years
after my decease. And I appoint my son James Freeman
& John Hays Executors & my wife Jane Executrix of this my last
will & Testament, And I do hereby renounce all former wills &
Testaments by me made; In witness whereof I have hereunto
