The direction of my executors, and as touching my testatorly estate in it shall please God to bless me with in this life, I give & dispense of the same in the following manner & form vizt All my right wife Give & bequeath unto my beloved daughter Elizabeth the sum of One Hundred & twenty pounds to her to be used for the clothing & ornaments of my daughter Elizabeth as she chooseth to accept of Him I will give & bequeath unto my beloved son David Haffell all singular & this tract of land or lot with the house thereon containing 131 acres of land with all the improvements thereon & also another tract lying between this & the Division (unimproved) containing 87 acres of land, and also all my right, that is to say 80 acres of land lately entered by me between my said daughter Elizabeth & Him I will give & bequeath unto my beloved daughter Elizabeth the Haffell all the residue of my real estate consisting of one tract containing 48 acres of land lying west from this house of mine in which I now live & bearing 100 acres of patent land in the name of Jas the will & bequeath unto her the said Eliza both the sum of One hundred, and likewise one farthing bed & furniture thereunto belonging. - This my further will & pleasure that all my books be be divided between my two last mentioned children by my daughter Elizabeth & the big Bible to David & all the remainder to Elizabeth. His further will & pleasure that all the remainder of my estate be sold by my executors & the money arising therefrom, after all my just debts are paid be equally divided between my two last mentioned children viz David & Elizabeth & their Heirs respectively but not in interest with security given and for their benefit until the severally arrive at the age of twenty one years of age. His further will & pleasure that if either of my said two children David Haffell & Elizabeth Haffell should die in this world before arriving at the age of twenty one years leaving no Heirs of their body, that then & in either of those cases the sum over shall have and bequeathable & enjoy in full the other inheritance.

of land lately entered lying between my field & house & the house
Him I will give & bequeath unto my beloved daughter Elizabeth Haffett

Haffett all the remainder of my land estate consisting of one
tract containing 48 acres of land lying west from this house of mine
in which I now live & bearing 100 acres of good land in his own
name & for the will & bequeath unto her the said Eliza late the
sum of Two hundred, and like wise ever after the birth of her son that she
shall bring up.

It is my will & pleasure that all my books be
be divided between my two last mentioned children by my executors
that I the big will to David & the remainder to Elizabeth
It is further will & pleasure that all the remainder of my estate be so
left by my executors & the money leaving therefore, after all my just debts
expaid be equally divided between my two last mentioned

children viz David & Elizabeth & their Heirs respectively but
not in interest with security to me and for this intent will
the severally give at the age of seventy one years of age

It is my further will & pleasure that if either of my said two children
David, Haffett & Elizabeth Haffett should die before the severance
is made at the age of seventy one years leaving no Heir of their
body; that then & in either of those cases the severance made here
had & occupy, perhaps & enjoy in full the other's estate by exception
that part both real and personal. - It is my will & pleasure
that the aforesaid ten pounds be taken from David's moiety & given
added to Elizabeth's moiety, after the severance is made

And Lastly I do hereby nominate & appoint my beloved son

Petruic Hoffett & my worthy friend John McHolland do make and subscribe to be my
whole & sole Executrix of this my last Will & Testament. Having recd a copy
of former Wills, gifts & legacies by me made or done. Reciting &
confirming this & no. letter to be my last will & testament, the Testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 17th
day of January 1778

County & State of Carolina, being by the affliction hand of God in a
few days of his life of his 87th age & but half past 80 years old I as yet am possessed
of a sound mind & judgment. Recalling to mind the Mortality
of the body & that it is appointed for all men once to die. Do constitute
ordain & appoint this to be my last Will & Testament in my name & from
henceforward principally & first of all I give & bequeath my service to God
who gave it. And concerning my worldly goods this I give them in
with I also will & dispose of them in the following manner -
Item I give & bequeath to my ever loving wife Eleanor White the import
of all my personal Estate after my lawful debts is paid & also the
benefit of the plantation I now live on with all the improvements
for the purpose of breeding & rearing my several children
to the age of Majority & also the Gray horse & a new woman's saddle
over her third part as apportioned. Item I give & bequeath to my son sons Thomas
John, William & James & the plantation I now live on to be equally
divided between them when they come to the age of twenty one years
and also their equal share of the remaining two thirds of my personal estate
Item I give & bequeath to my three daughters Mary, Sarah & Martha
each their equal part of all the remainder of my personal estate that is
I give after my ever loving wife receives her part the other two thirds
of the Plantation is then to be alien-
