of Mecklenburg & State of N^o Carolina being far advanced
in years weak & infirm in body, believing & knowing that all
men must die, think proper while my faculties are yet
sound & my memory perfect to dispose of what worldly
property I now possess in manner & form following
In presence I will that all my lawful Debts be duly discharged &
paid out of my Estate—Then I will & bequeath to my son
David Robinson his Heirs & assigns forever all that part of
my land on which I now live—Then I will Henrys Com
monitories to my son Robert Robinson & that he be under
obligations to let his brother & sisters have a reasonable
use of them—Then I will that all the rest of my books be
equally divided amongst my children also my riding
horns saddles & all such notes or bonds I will & direct to be
equally divided amongst them—Then I will & bequeath
to my grandson Archibald Robinson the tract of Land
on which my son now resides, provided that
Archibald Robinson shall possess in said house & his
heirs to have possession of said tract of Land & enjoy the profits
arising from the cultivation of it during their natural life
Lastly I do hereby revoke all other wills by me made
heretofore & constitute & appoint Andrew Henderson
my son Robert Robinson Executors of this my last will &
