

I David Wilson of the County of North Carolina & State of N. Carolina Do make this my last Will & Testament inly I do will that all my just debts & funeral expenses be paid. — I do will & bequeath unto my son Samuel Wilson a tract of Land adjoining Robert Wilson & William J. Wilson & Others containing ninety eight acres, & also a tract of Land known by Downson place containing one hundred acres — I will & bequeath unto my daughter Polly Waight one negro girl named Sue & her child during her natural life then to be Equally divided amongst her surviving Children — I will & unto my son Samuel Wilson one third part of the Value of all my negroes Except Sue which is hereafter disposed of — I will & bequeath unto my son Charles Winslow Wilson one third part of the Value of all my negroes Except Sue which I allow to live with which ever of my Children she wishes I will that the other third part of the Value of my negroes to be put into the hands of my Executors for the Support of my son H. S. Wilson & my Executors to pay the Interest of the Amount Annually during his life, then the principal to be Equally divided betwixt my three Children viz Samuel Wilson, Mr. W. Wilson, Polly Waight, It is also my request that my son Chas. W. Wilson take the negroes that may be Valued for the Support of H. S. Wilson & pay the Value into the hands of my Executors — I do will & bequeath unto my son Benjamin Wilson two Children, Hannah & Mary one hundred dollars each — I will that the plantation that I live on be sold with all my stocks of every kind farming tools & all of my property

not heretofore written Except my Bible, Belton book do  
step which I allow to my son Samuel Wilson —  
I do appoint my friend Doct<sup>r</sup> J<sup>r</sup> McNeill & my son  
Chas<sup>r</sup> W Wilson my Executors of this my last will and

29<sup>th</sup> 1820.

if any be put out to interest for the benefit of my  
heir after named Children to be given them as  
they marry or arrive of age & It is my will do  
desire that my Negro man Harry be hired out  
by my Executor from year to year to some good  
Master & the monies arising therefrom to be put  
out to interest from year to year till my youngest  
child becomes of age or marries, then all the said  
monies with the valuation of my negro man Harry  
to be equally divided between my four Children  
viz John, Caroline, Hickory & Henry g<sup>ods</sup> It is my
