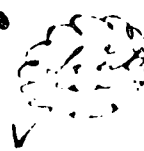


State of New York Dutchess County.

To my dear beloved wife which she is not despoor of in her life time & at her death to be divided & equally among the Legates & after that Third the remain der Equally divided amongst my children except my son Samuel Hannigan I leave him fifteen dollars over & above his Equale share I leave to my daughter Sarah each an thirty dollars over & above her Equale share - And I hereby make & Ordain my worthy friends my beloved wife Margaret Hannigan & Samuel Hannigan Executors of this my last Will & Testament. In Witnes whereof I the said Denis Hannigan have to this my last Will & Testament set my hand & seal the day & date above written signed, sealed, Published & declared by the said Denis Hannigan the Testator as his last Will & Testament in presence of us who were present at the time of signing & sealing thereof
