3^d I Give & bequeath to my beloved son David Whitten my negro boy named Sam, by him paying to my daughter Margaret Polk one third of her Valuation, also I Give & bequeath to him myself of Cherry Tree Table and my Clock & Case.

4th I Give & bequeath to my beloved daughter Margaret Polk one third of the Valuation of my negro Girl named Amy & the one third of the Valuation of my negro boy named Sam as also above in my bequests to my son David Whitten & my daughter Isabella Adeline, also a bed & furniture & one of my best Trunks, also one third of my cupboards furniture also a looking Glass --- Further, I Will that the remainder of my property not herein bequeathed be sold & the money arising therefrom be equally divided among my children --- Further I hereby make & ordain my worthy friends William Campbell & James Parker son of Alexander Parker Executors of this my last Will & Testament, In Witness whereof I the said David Hart have to this my last Will & Testament set my hand & seal the day & Year above written - signed sealed & published & declared by the said David Hart as my last Will in the presence of us who were present at the time of signing & sealing thereof -
