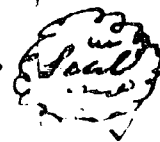

my well beloved son whom I likewise constitute make & bequeath my
only & sole Executor of this my last will & Testament all & singular my
Lands, chepneys & Tenements by him fully to be possessed, held & enjoyed
and do hereby utterly disallow revoke & discharge all & every
other former Testaments will & Legacies bequeathed & executed by

me my wife before this time, name will & signature by me
 Ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last will & Testament it
