my nephew David Davis the sum of Twenty pounds to be paid  
to him by my executors as soon as may be convenient after  
my decease; & also I give & bequeath to my trustee friend  
Sarah Price the plantation on which I now live to him his  
heirs & assigns forever; I likewise give & bequeath to the above  
named Sarah Price the whole of my stock of every kind to  
go there with all utensils belonging belonging to the place  
of time or in any manner belonging to my estate & likewise  
my bed & furniture with the whole of my wearing apparel  
lastly I do make & constitute to James Morrison & Sarah  
Price executors of this my last will & testament, Not  
signing & confirming this & no other as my last will  
& Testament dated this 11<sup>th</sup> day of January in  
the year of our Lord 1803.
