and Executors of this my last Will & Testament. In Witness

Testament set my hand & seal this day & Year above written.

Chicklumbury & State of North Carolina being weak in body but yet
in perfect mind & memory thanks be to God for it; and therefore
calling to mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it
is appointed for all persons, once to die; I do make & Ordain
this my last Will & Testament. And first of all I give my soul
unto the hands of God Almighty God that gave it & my
body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a decent manner
at the discretion of my Executors And as Touching my worldly
affairs wherein it hath pleased God to bless me with in this
life I give & dispose of the same in the following manner & form
as follows; First of all I desire all my lawful Debts may be paid

Item. I leave the use of my plantation where I now live to my daughter Elizabeth for the term of three years after my decease & then to be sold at public sale and to be equally divided between my four daughters Catharine Moore & Mary Gabbreth & Susannah Morgan & Elizabeth Finney—Item. I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth one Heifer called Glenney—Item. I give & bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Jennet one Cow named Cherry and her Heifer—Item. I give & bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth one Eider Down & likewise it is my Will & pleasure that my Daughter Susannah shall have my Chest & two pots & my cotton ware, and further it is my desire that what pewter I have may be equally divided betwixt my Daughter Susannah & my Grand daughter Jennet, & further it is my Will & pleasure that my Grand Daughter Jennet shall have my bed & furniture & spinning wheel & Reels—Item. I give & bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth all my Wags & I desire her to pay all my debts, and I do hereby constitute & appoint my son Hugh Morgan & Samuel Black to be my sole Executors to this my last Will and Test. must disannulling all & every other former Wills & Testaments & Legacies be me named Wills & bequeathed before; testifying & confirming this & no other to be my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I the said Eleanor Finney hath hereunto set her hand & affixed her seal this 8th day of March 1800 Signed sealed & delivered by the said Eleanor Finney to be her last Will & Testament in the presence of us who in the presence of each other have hereunto set our names
