I Eleanor Finney of the County of Rockingham & State of North Carolina being weak in body but yet in perfect mind & memory thankes to god for it; and therefore willing to make the mortallite of my body & thenceas that it is appointed for all persons, once to die, I do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament, and first of all I give my soul unto the hands of God almighty God that gave it & my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent manner at the discretion of my executors and as touching my worldly affairs wherein it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I give & dispose of the same in the following manner & form as follows; first of all I desire all my lawfull debts may be paid

74 Item. I leave the use of my plantation where I now live to my daughter Elizabeth for the term of three years after my decease & then to be sold at publick sale and to be equally divided between my four daughters Catharine & Anne & Mary Galbreath & Susannah Morgan & Elizabeth Finney. Item. I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Eliza-
-beth one Heifer called Gloucester. Item. I give & bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Jemima one Cow named Cherry and her Heifer.
Item. I give & bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth our Eldest
Daughter it is my will & pleasure that my Daughter Su-
-sannah shall have my Chest & two Pots & my cushion ware, and
further it is my desire that what jewels I have may be equal-
ly divided betwixt my Daughter Susannah & my Grand Daugh-
ter Jemima, & further it is my will & pleasure that my Grand
Daughter Jemima shall have my bed & furniture & spinning
wheel & Reel. Item. I give & bequeath unto my daughter Eliz-
-abeth all my Hogs & I desire her to pay all my debts, land I do
hereby constitute & appoint my Son Hugh Morgan & Samuel
Black to be my sole Executrix to this my last Will and Testam-
ent disowning all & every other former Wills & Testaments &
Sayinge be me named will'd & you attested before; Ratifying
& confirming this & no other to be my last will & Testament

unto set her hand & affixed her seal this 27th day of March 1800
