Item. I desire to my nephew Robert Allen his heirs & assigns forever my negro woman Lucy & her children together with all their increase & profit, This devise is made in consideration of love & affection toward my said nephew & in consideration of his many important kind services rendered to me & also in consideration of due tenderness & regard to my said negro woman & her children Item. I desire to my niece Nancy Callans my house & bed and furniture. - Item. I desire to my friend Robert H. Callans the sum of ten dollars. Item. I desire to my relative Eleanor Duckworth the sum of ten dollars, - Item. I desire to my relation Mary and Duckworth the sum of ten dollars - Item. I desire that as soon as the resources of the estate shall fail in complying with the preceding devise that my aforesaid nephew Robert Allen furnish & pay the balance, Let it be noted & remembered that the reason why other relations are not interested & endow'd in this instrument is because my estate does not admit of it. Finally. I do hereby constitute & appoint my beloved said nephew and my true & trusty friend James Morris (Purser) the executors of this my last will & testament Published this 7th day of August 1824.
