perty shall remain in the hands of my Executor & Guardian
till my Grand son Thomas M. Alexander comes to full age of 21
then it is my will that my property be valued & that Thomas
& Alexander my Grand son to get the one third & the other two
parts I Will to my Grand daughter Susanah & Alexander
It is my will that if my Grand daughter Susanah Eliza should
depart this life before she should have lawful Heirs, then in that
case I Will to James Spratt Jun^r the Bureau that I have
above written to S. E. Alexander my Grand daughter, It is my
will that if either of my Grand children should depart this life
without leaving lawful Heirs that the surviving one shall have
the whole of my property that is not above written. It is my will
I also Will that if both my Grand children should depart this
life before that they should have lawful Heirs, then in that case
I Will the whole of my property to James Spratt Jun^r my Cousin
to him & his Heirs forever - I do hereby nominate James Spratt
Executor of this my last will & Testament, and I do hereby no-
minate James Spratt Guardian of this my last will. In witness
