I Will that my two grand children Susannah & Susannah Eloisa & their mother Eleanor & their mother Eleanor of my property (the business excepted) to be divided between them as follows first I Will my business to my grand daughter Susannah Eloisa also will that the rest of my property shall be made in the hands of my executor & guardian till my grand son Thomas & Matthew come to full age of 21 then it my will that my property be divided I will Thomas & Matthew my grandsons to get the one third & the other two parts I will to my grand daughter Susannah E. Martin It is my will that if my grand daughter Susannah should depart this life before she should have lawful heirs then in that case I will to James Spratt junior the business that I have above directed to S. E. Martin my grand daughter It is my will that if either of my grand children should depart this life without leaving lawful heirs that the surviving one shall have the whole of my property that is not given with his or her child I also will that if both my grand children should depart this life before that they should have lawful heirs then & in that case I divide the whole of my property to James Spratt during my life & his widow & after her death to James Spratt Executor of this my last will & testament and I do hereby nominate James Spratt his & widow Susannah James Spratt Executor of this my last will & testament and I do hereby nominate William Fletcher to witness whereof I do here set my hand & seal this 16th day of May A.D. 1825 signed sealed in presence of us
