 that it is appointed, once for all men to die, I make this my last
 will & Testament, And dispose of all my worldly estate as follows

 part of my Estate, I give & bequeath to my beloved son Levier —
 from one Dollar to the full amount of his part my Estate, I give
 & bequeath to my daughter Mary one Dollar to the full amt^t
 of her part of my Estate, I give & bequeath to my son Wichard
 the amount of one dollar to the full amount of his part of
 my Estate, I give & bequeath to my daughter Sarah one dollar
 to the full amount of her part of my Estate, I give & bequeath
 to my daughter Elizabeth one dollar to the amount of her full
 part of my Estate, I give & bequeath to my daughter Ann one
 Dollar to the full amount of her part of my Estate, I give &
 bequeath to my daughter Cathy one dollar to the full amt^t
 of her part of my Estate, I give & bequeath to my daughter
Biddy Horn one dollar to the amount of her part of my Estate,
 I give & bequeath to my son Alexander Burton one dollar
 to the amount of his part of my Estate, I give & bequeath
 to my beloved brother in law John Caigle Daughter Cathy
Caigle the amount of five hundred dollars to the full part
 of my Estate due to me by my brother William Horn —
 I give & bequeath to my Brother in law John Caigle one bay
 mare saddle & bridle & sixty dollars due to me by my Mother
Sarah Horn — I also appoint my friend John Caigle my
 Executor, In Shew Hereunto set my hand & seal this day
 and date, first — Signed, Sealed & delivered in
