Christian burial at the discretion of my Son nothing doubt-
ing but at the general resurrection I shall receive the

estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life I
give & bequeath of the same in the following manner & form
and first I give & bequeath to my daughter Mary fifty
pounds Sterling money to be paid her & her husband out of my estate
& Augt I have left her old age. Next come my Land to my son
to be possessed by him only my daughter is to have for her
