tality of my body knowing it is appointed unto me
to die. First I will my dear & precious Estate viz
First I will & give unto my wife Polly Sibley
my plantation whereon I now live with all the house
hold & kitchen furniture, and all my stock and three
negroes to wit Charles, Leith & Rose including her natural
life & at her death the property to be equally divided
between my two youngest sons William Sibley & James
Sibley; Also I will that my son John H. Sibley has one
hundred Acres of Land whereon he now lives including
his improvements, Also I give unto my son Abraham
Sibley one dollar it being his part, Also I give unto
my daughter Mary Went five dollars it being her part
Also I will my son Elijah M. Sibley one dollar it being
his part, Also I will the heirs of Colman Sibley one
dollar it being their part in part of my Estate Also I
will my daughter Elizabetta Haley one Negro to wit Affe
it being her part in full of my Estate Also I will my
daughter Polly Sibley the wife of Leonard Sibley one
dollar it being her part of my Estate.

First I nominate my son Samuel Sibley as my Executor
to act upon all my Estate as Agent for my wife and
Guardian for my two sons William & James Sibley
Ande this & this only to be my last Will & Testament
Whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal
this the 10th day of September 1831.

State of N. Carolina Wake County Oct 11th 1828
 In the name of God Amen I John Alexander of the State of
 County of Wake being of sound mind & memory, do make
 & publish this my last Will & Testament in manner &
 form following Viz. I resign my soul to God who gave
 it & my body to the earth to be buried at the discretion
 of my Executors; And Touching such worldly Estate
 as it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I
 dispose of in the following manner & form.

1st I give & bequeath to my son John F. Alexander the
 whole of my plantation whereon I live containing
 about three hundred & seventy acres to him his heirs
 and forever - Subject nevertheless to a descent sup-
 port for daughter Abigail Alexander, which I mean
 to be capable of managing her own affairs. Also a
 negro boy named Amos, whose one bed & furniture
 I allow to the afore named John F. Alexander

2nd I give & bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Campbell
 my negro girl Mary which she has in her possession, also
 a girl named Julia sister to Mary afore named -

3rd I give & bequeath to my son Lyman Alexander one
 negro boy named Hester which he has in his posses-
 sion, also one boy named Barton together with one
 bed & furniture -

4th I will & bequeath to my daughter Sophia Alexander
 my negro girl named Matilda & a boy named Jack
 also a negro girl named Venus & a negro girl named
 Julia likewise one bed & furniture -

5th It is my will & pleasure that the whole of the remains
 of my property not yett divided be sold at the discretion
 of my Executors, and all monies on hand or due me
 or becoming due be applied to the payment of my
 just debts, and the balance if any to be Equally

divided amongst my four children viz. Cyrus A
Alexander, Isaac F. Alexander, Elizabeth Campbell &
Sophia Alexander each I hereby nominate constitute
& appoint my son Isaac F. Alexander, John Campbell
& James Wilson Executors of this my last Will & Testament
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand &
Seal the day & year above written: ...

Item I Give & bequeath to my my beloved daughter
Mary Wilson all the property that I have heretofore
given her & also a negro girl named, Edwice about
Thirteen years old the daughter of my negro woman
