 appointed heretofore Ratifying & confirming this & no

 & seal this 9th day of August in the Year of our Lord 1787

Richard & Elizabeth the child of which my wife Mary is
now pregnant. And I do hereby nominate & appoint
my Executors Frederick Smith & my Son Francis Burwell
Smith Executors of this my last will & Testament, requesting
& advising them to keep my estate together undivided
until my said Son Francis come of age, & it is also my
Request & Injunction that my youngest Children it all
when they respectively arrive at the age of sixteen years
be taken from under the ^{immediate & contrary} direction of my Lawful wife
Mary & be Educated under the direction of My Executors
